The undersigned is directed to refer to Ministry of External Affairs' email dated 28th May, 2020 on the subject cited above and to say that the para 2 (ii) of Standard Operating Protocol (SOP) for movement of persons stranded in India who are desirous to travel abroad issued vide MHA order of even number dated 24th May, 2020 is modified as under:

Only those persons shall be allowed to travel to the destination countries, who are citizens of that country; who have a green card or OCI card; Indian Nationals who are holding visa of that country, with a minimum residual validity of three months. In case an Indian National is having confirmed offer of employment / internship / admission in education institution, he/ she can be allowed with visa of that country, with a minimum residual validity of one month.
