ORDER

The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) vide order no. 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 22.08.2020 has issued the Standard Operating Protocol (SOP), for international travel on non-scheduled commercial flights under Vande Bharat Scheme and Air Transport Bubble Arrangement. Clause 2B(iii) of the Annexure to the above order states that, the persons who are eligible to travel on the out-bound flights, will apply to the Ministry of Civil Aviation (MoCA) or to an agency/agencies designated by MoCA for this purpose with necessary details, including places of departure and arrival.

The Ministry of Civil Aviation hereby designates all the airlines 2. operating under Vande Bharat Scheme and Air Transport Bubble Arrangements as designated agencies for the purpose of the above clause. The passengers may book the tickets directly with the airlines concerned and need not apply/register with the Ministry of Civil Aviation. If needed, the Ministry may seek such data from the agencies being designated as such.
